## Demonstration of 2-colour cast on, 2-colour rib and short rows:

## Requirements:

Yarn: 2 colours Cowgirlblues Merino twist

Needles: 3.5 mm

## With 3.5mm needles cast on 48sts in 2-colour longtail cast on method

Row 1: hold colour A in left hand and B in right hand. \*colour A: k1, colour B: p1\* repeat to end of row

Row 2: hold B in left hand and A in right hand. \*B: k1, A: p1\* repeat to end of row

Repeat these 2 rows until you are comfortable with knitting a 2-colour rib.

Next 2 rows; k in colour B Wave pattern: in colour A:

Wave 1: k21, turn, sl 1p, p17, turn, sl 1k, k14, turn, sl 1p, p11, turn, sl 1k, k13, turn, sl 1p, p15, turn, sl 1k, k17, turn, sl 1p, p19, turn, sl 1k, k21

Repeat for wave 2

Next row: p

Next 2 rows: k in colour B (or C if using 3 colours)

In colour A: k5, turn, sl 1p, p4, k2, turn, sl 1p, p1, turn, k4, turn, sl 1p, p3, turn, k6, turn, sl 1p, p5, k10

Next wave: k21, turn, sl 1p, p17, turn, sl 1k, k14, turn, sl 1p, p11, turn, sl 1k, k13, turn, sl 1p, p15, turn, sl 1k, k17, turn, sl 1p, p19, turn, sl 1k, k21

To finish off the line: k14, turn, p11, turn, sl 1k, k10, turn, p8, turn, sl 1k, k7, turn, p10, turn, sl 1k, k9, turn, p12, turn, sl 1k, k11.

Next row: p

Repeat from the beginning.

## Abbreviations:

k knit p purl

sl 1p slip 1 purlwise (with yarn in front) sl 1k slip 1 knitwise (with yarn in back)
