

## Cowgirlblues logcabin blanket

## Requirements:

Yarn: 12 x Cowgirlblues Aran singles Needles: 5.5mm Dpn's(double pointed needle)/sosatie sticks clips/ pegs/ elastic bands to hold work on dpn's

## Notes:

Slip first stitch of every row. On a knit row slip st knitwise (with yarn at back of work), on a purl row slip st purlwise (with yarn in front of work) This creates a neat edge which is easy to pick up stitches from.



## Log cabin square: Centre block: Provisional cast on 15 sts 19 rows in stocking st. Don't cast off, leave the sts on a dpn. Log #1: Pick up 10sts down side of centre block. 8 rows in stocking st. Leave sts on dpn Log #2: Pick up 4 sts from side of #1 and 15 sts from provisional cast on. 8 rows in stocking st. Leave sts on dpn Log #3: Pick up 4 sts from side of #2 and 10 sts from side of centre block. 8 rows in stocking st. Leave sts on dpn. Pick up 4 sts from side of #3, 15 sts from side of centre block and 5 sts from side of #1. Log #4: 8 rows in stocking st. Leave sts on dpn. Log #5: Pick up 4 sts from side of #4, sts on dpn of log #1, 5 sts from side of #2. 8 rows in stocking st. Leave sts on dpn. Pick up 4 sts from side of #5, sts on dpn of log #2, 5 sts from side of #3. 8 rows in Log #6: stocking st. Leave sts on dpn. Log #7: Pick up 4 sts from side of #6, sts on dpn of log #3, 5 sts from side of #4. 8 rows in stocking st. Leave sts on dpn. Pick up 4 sts from side of #7, sts on dpn of log #4, 5 sts from side of #5. 8 rows in Log #8: stocking st. Leave sts on dpn. Pick up 4 sts from side of #8, sts on dpn of log #5, 5 sts from side of #6. 8 rows in Log #9: stocking st. Cast off knitwise Pick up 4 sts from side of #9, sts on dpn of log #6, 5 sts from side of #7. 8 rows in Log #10: stocking st. Cast off knitwise Pick up 4 sts from side of #10, sts on dpn of log #7, 5 sts from side of #8. 8 rows in Log#11: stocking st. Cast off knitwise Pick up 4 sts from side of #11, sts on dpn of log #8, 5 sts from side of #9. 8 rows in Log #12: stocking st. Cast off knitwise

Knit 20 blocks.

Sew together 5x4 using Kitchener and matrass stitch. Knit a rib on each side to finish off.
